Instructions for Online Poster and Oral Presentations

- All Abstracts should be submitted in English only.
- Abstracts submitted by e-mail, fax or post will NOT be accepted.
- The abstracts have to be structured as follows:

Introduction (Background & Aim): Hypothesis

Material & Methods (or Case study): Study design, Subjects, Setting, Intervention(s), Outcome measurement(s), Independent variables, Analyses

Results: Main outcome(s) of the study, including confidence levels or p values

Conclusions: Supported by the results, both positive and negative.



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- The abstracts for oral and poster presentations should be submitted until **December 18, 2026**.
- All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The abstracts scheduled for oral presentations will be announced on **January 8, 2027**. The rest will be displayed as posters.
- The Scientific Committee will select the first five to be presented in Prize session.
- These finalists will present their studies to the Jury during the prize session and the winner will be awarded with **"IVS Prize Certificate"** and 1.000 EUR.
- A certificate will be delivered to all finalist presentations.

Located in one of Athens most vibrant neighborhoods, Divani Caravel is just minutes from Syntagma Square, the city's focal landmark, and a short stroll from the trendy Kolonaki district, filled with fashionable boutiques, popular cafes, and restaurants. 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VISITOR INFORMATION

Languages of Greece: The official language of Greece is Greek. However, English is widely spoken, particularly in hotels, restaurants, shops and tourist areas. International visitors will generally have no difficulty communicating in English.

Currency: Euro (EUR)

Weather: Athens enjoys a Mediterranean climate. In March, the weather is generally mild and pleasant. Average daytime temperatures range between 15°C and 20°C, while evening temperatures may drop to around 9°C–12°C. Occasional rain showers may occur, but sunny days are common, making it a comfortable time to explore the city.

Electricity: The electricity supply in Athens follows the European standard:

Voltage: 230 V, Frequency: 50 Hz, Plug Types: Type C (Europlug) and Type F (Schuko), Visitors from countries using different standards should bring an appropriate travel adapter.

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International Airports

- Athens International Airport (ATH): Located about 33 kilometers east of Athens city center. It is the main international gateway to Greece and serves millions of passengers each year.
- Flights to Athens: Direct flights are available from major European cities such as London, Paris, Berlin, Rome, Madrid, and Barcelona, as well as intercontinental flights from North America, the Middle East, and Asia.

Airport Transfer Options:

- **Airport Shuttle / Private Transfer:** Shared shuttle services and private transfers are available from the airport to the city center and major hotels.

Important Note: Roundtrip transfer Athens Elefterios Venizelos International Airport-Divani Caravel Hotel-Athens Elefterios Venizelos International Airport can be provided for participants who received the accommodation service **from Serenas Group (Official Agent of the VAI Meeting) together with announced accommodation fees.**

- **Public Transport:** Athens Metro Line 3 (Blue Line) connects Athens International Airport to the city center, including Syntagma Square, in approximately 40 minutes.
- **Airport Bus:** Express bus routes (X95, X96, X97, X93) operate 24 hours a day between the airport and key locations in Athens.
- **Taxi and Ride-Sharing:** Licensed taxis are available at the airport arrival area, and ride-sharing services can also be used.

By Train

International Trains

- From Thessaloniki, Greece: Direct train connections are available between Thessaloniki and Athens (duration approximately 4–5 hours).
- From Sofia, Bulgaria: Train connections are available via Thessaloniki, although schedules may vary and transfers may be required.
- From Belgrade, Serbia: Train connections to Athens are available with transfers via Thessaloniki.

Please note that international rail connections to Athens may require transfers and schedules should be checked in advance.

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Domestic Trains

- From other Greek cities: Athens is connected by rail to major cities within Greece, including Thessaloniki, Larissa, Volos, and Patras.

Rail services are operated by Hellenic Train, which provides intercity and regional train services across the country.

Train Stations in Athens

- Athens Railway Station (Larissa Station): The main railway station in Athens, serving both domestic and international routes.
- Piraeus Railway Station: Located near Port of Piraeus, serving regional routes and connections to the Athens metro network.

By Car

From Nearby Countries:

- From Sofia, Bulgaria: Drive via the A1/E79 and E75 highways, approximately 7–8 hours.
- From Skopje, North Macedonia: Take the E75 highway, approximately 7 hours.
- From Tirana, Albania: Via the SH2 and E86 highways, approximately 8–9 hours.
- From Istanbul, Türkiye: Drive via the O-3 / E80 and E90 highways, approximately 10–11 hours.

Distance from Athens to the main European cities:

- 1.Sofia, Bulgaria:** Approximately 790 kilometers (490 miles) to the north.
- 2.Skopje, North Macedonia:** Approximately 700 kilometers (435 miles) to the northwest.
- 3.Tirana, Albania:** Approximately 720 kilometers (447 miles) to the northwest.
- 4.Istanbul, Türkiye:** Approximately 1,090 kilometers (677 miles) to the northeast.
- 5.Rome, Italy:** Approximately 1,050 kilometers (652 miles) to the west (including ferry routes).
- 6.Vienna, Austria:** Approximately 1,400 kilometers (870 miles) to the northwest.
- 7.Berlin, Germany:** Approximately 2,100 kilometers (1,305 miles) to the northwest.
- 8.Paris, France:** Approximately 2,100 kilometers (1,305 miles) to the northwest.
- 9.London, United Kingdom:** Approximately 2,400 kilometers (1,490 miles) to the northwest.

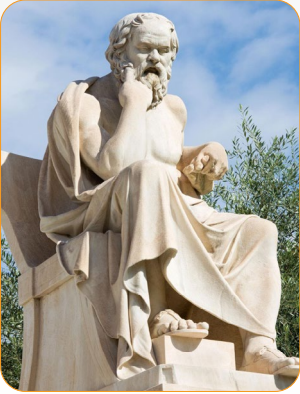

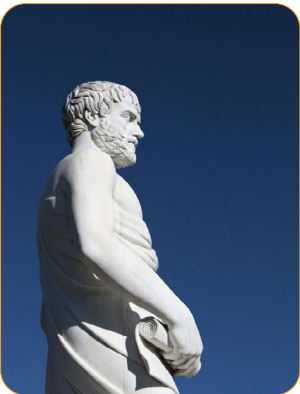
Socrates

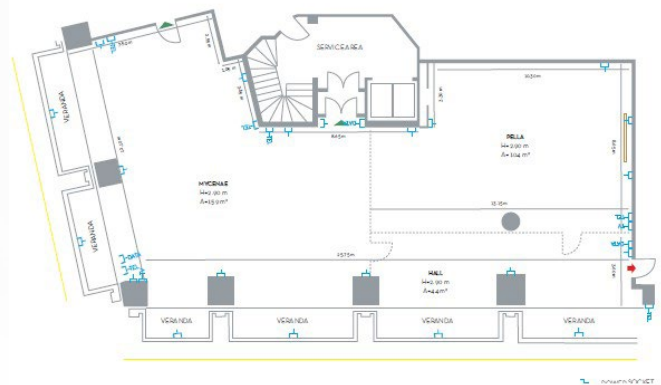

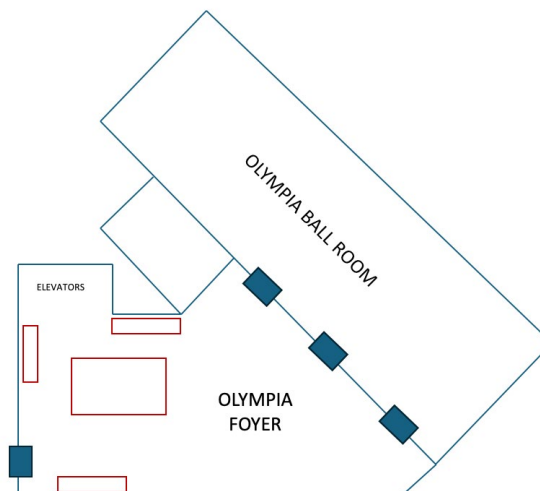
